Summary: The OGS wishes to express its position on elements of Inclusion, Diversity, Equity & Accessibility (IDEA) for purposes of membership and Artistic Season planning.

IDEA definitions and terms of reference

The following are references compiled and adapted from three English (3) dictionaries.

Inclusivity: the absence of exclusion of individuals or groups.

Diversity: the demonstration and/or representation of a variety of individuals among the group.

Equity: the fair and equal treatment of all individuals.

Accessibility: the lack of barriers for individuals to reach places or to enjoy events.

Demographic and identity factors: any and all protected grounds under the *Canadian Human Rights Act*¹ and/or the *Ontario Human Rights Code*² and/or the *Québec Charter of Human Rights and Freedoms*³.
